### Priorities 2021-22

- Reduce the level of anxiety in Cycle 2 and 3 by teaching students strategies to recognize signs and self-regulate
- Mindfulness activities in all grades headed by homeroom teachers to offer students times to self-reflect and learn effective strategies to lower anxiety
- Talk circles in grades 4 to 6 boys/girls headed by special education technicians to learn to discuss openly and respectfully about disagreements and focus on ways to resolve issues without violence
- Tangage activities for Grades 4 to 6 from community resources
- Boxes for anonymous communication in classrooms where students can share concerns or issues that make them feel unsafe
