

Principal's Report Tuesday, November 8th, 2016 GB

- Report cards will be sent home during the day on the 15th of November. Parent/teacher interviews will be held in two after school sessions on November 16th.
- IEP meetings have been completed at the elementary level. The high school IEP meeting will be held shortly.
- School fees paid to date: 94% at the elementary level. This does not include the pre-K as they started the end of September. 86% at the high school level have paid. There have been arrangements made with several parents in regards to the school fees.
- We are waiting for our Measure d'acueil funding. This is funding for students arriving from out of province. As soon as we have received the funding, we will ask the teachers to add additional students who may benefit.
- November 11th Remembrance Day Ceremony will be held this Friday at 10:45 in the gym. The grade 4's to secondary 5 students will be attending. The ceremony is being organized by the secondary 5s and Mrs. Wilkins. The cadets will be taking part in the ceremony.
