

Principal's Report Tuesday, April 11, 2017

The John Abbott Caravan on April 5th was very successful with our students and the students from John Abbott. Our students were complimented in terms of their inquisitiveness, thoughtful questions and being genuinely good kids. A couple of the JA teachers said that there was a happy feeling to the school.
